Heart / Lung Problems	Too Much Blood Thinner
A productive or frothy cough	Bleeding from gums, mouth, nose or rectum
New congestion	Bruising
Increased shortness of breath	Leg pain
More swelling in legs or feet	Tarry stools
Weight gain of 2-3 lbs. in 24 Hrs.	
Signs of infection	Urinary problems
Increased redness	Foul odor to urine
More or different drainage	Catheter not draining
Wound / area gets bigger	Back or flank pain
Wound / area is more painful	Not able to urinate
Temperature of 100 or more	Increased weakness
Change or new odor from wound.	Bloody, cloudy or change in urine color

Sudden weakness	No bowel movement in 3 days
Uncomfortable thirsts or hunger	New skin problems
Sudden dizziness	Change in balance, coordination, strength
Increased urination	Fall with small or no injury
